Lunch information:

We can recommend Cantine in Institute of Informatics (small yellow/orange building between Day 1 and Day 2 locations).

Cantine usually has 1-4 meals at prices around 3-5 USD per lunch.

Restaurace Lapák on the map is also very good and on those days they will prepare lunch menus also in English language.

Lunch typically costs 4-6 USD.

Next to metro station there are two other restaurants, one in Kulturní dům Ládví which has fairly good meals with lunch prices between 4-6 USD and a Chinese restaurant (3-6 USD). Pizzeria Giovanni is the most expensive restaurant around Ládví.

Day 1 location is the tallest building around (yellow/red colour) with 7 floors. It is just behind the horizontally grey/red striped building of Thermomechanics which is visible from main road closer to metro station.

Day 2 location is the only blue building around with 4 floors.
