To provide a review and update of essential pharmacology for the various local anesthetics formulations and anesthetic techniques that are in use will be the main aim of this paper.

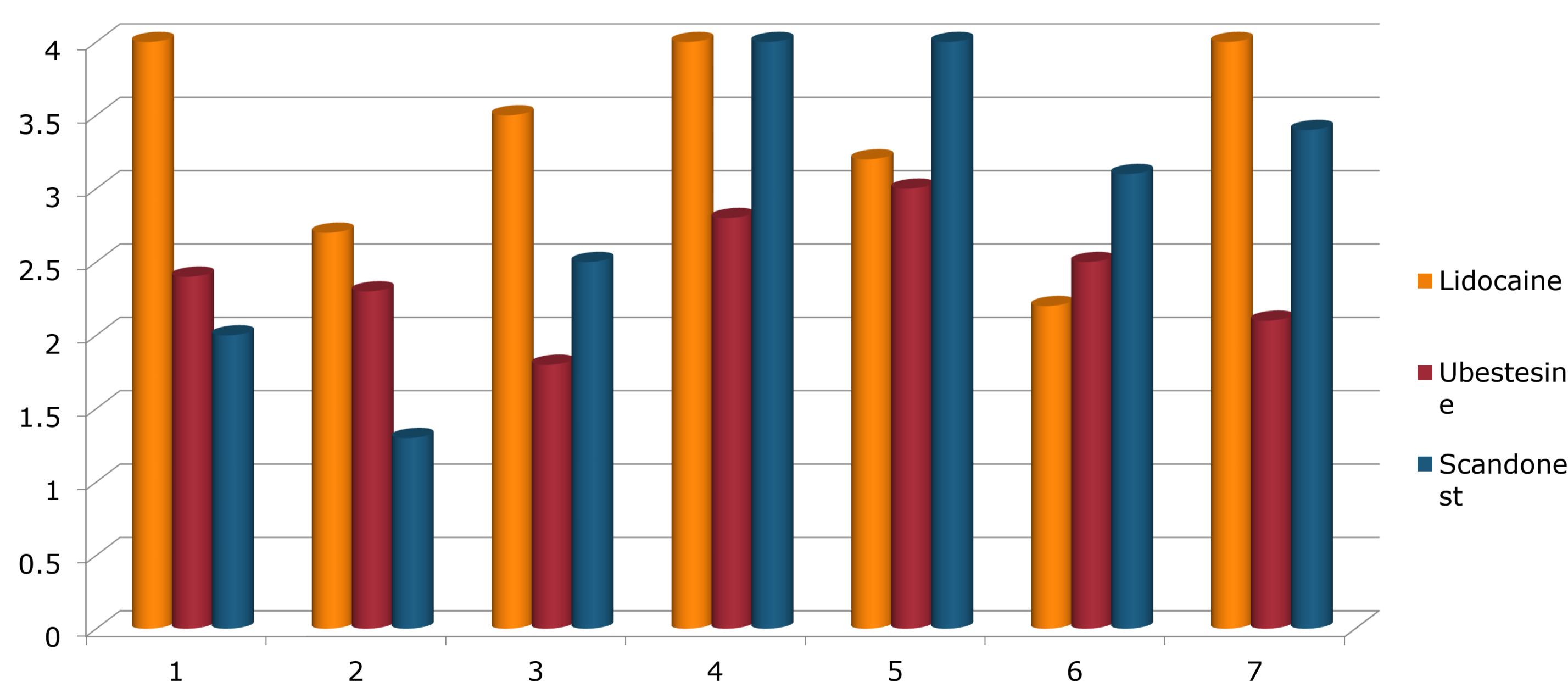
MATERIAL AND METHODS

To realize the aim 7 dental offices had been used for the purpose of this research, which were expected to give answers to the following questions:

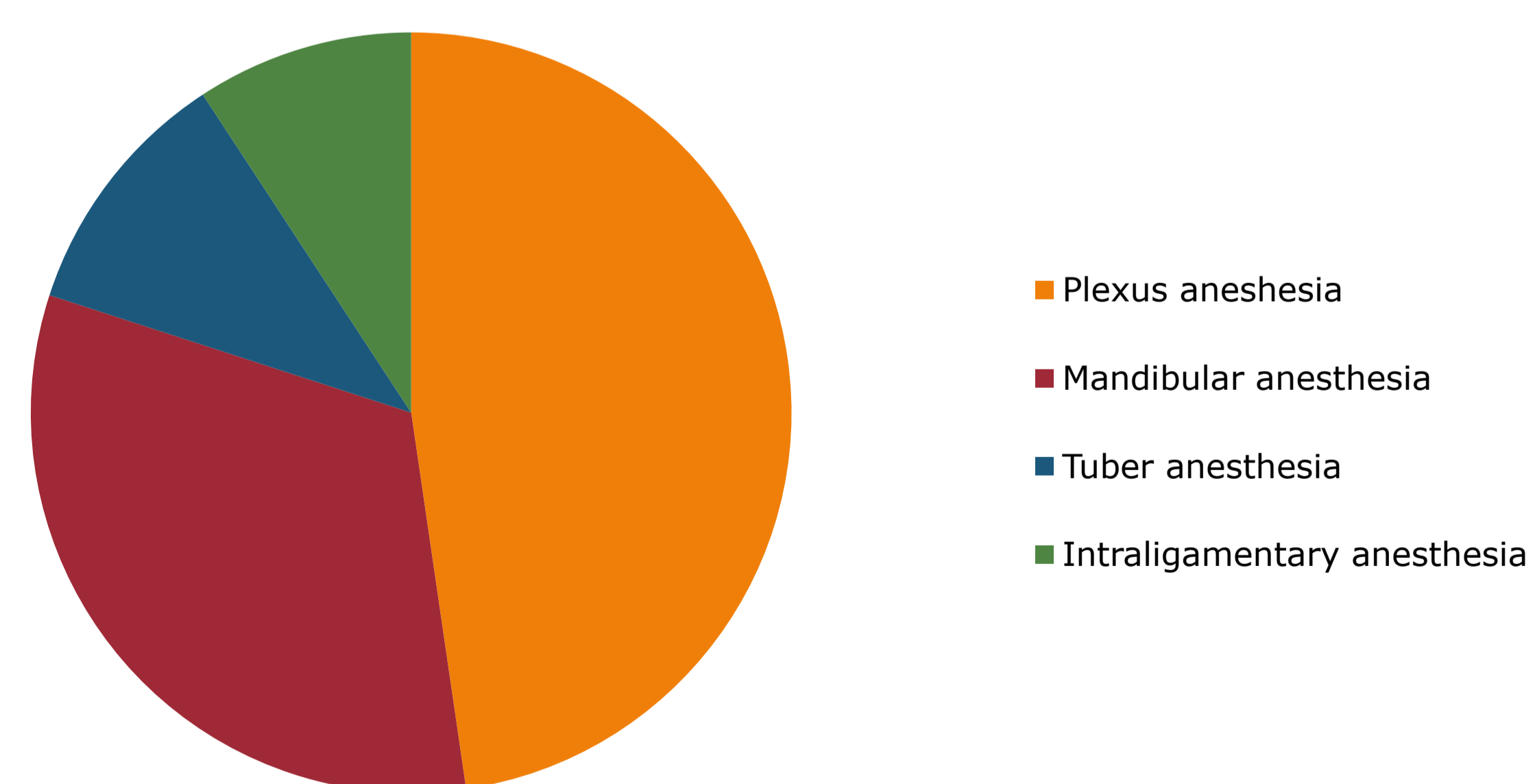
1. What is the most used anesthetic by them?
