IASI, THE CULTURAL CAPITAL OF ROMANIA



Iasi is the largest city in eastern Romania and the seat of Iași County. Located in the Moldavia region, Iași has traditionally been one of the leading centres of Romanian social, cultural, academic and artistic life.

Known as **The Cultural Capital of Romania**, Iași is a symbol in Romanian history and the main economic and business centre of the Moldavian region of Romania.

Home to the oldest Romanian university and to the first engineering school, Iași is one of the most important education and research centres of the country. The social and cultural life revolves around the Vasile Alecsandri National Theater (the oldest in Romania), the Moldova State Philharmonic, the Opera House, the Iași Athenaeum, a famous Botanical Garden (the oldest and largest in Romania), the Central University Library (the oldest in Romania), the high quality cultural centres and festivals, an array of museums, memorial houses, religious and historical monuments. The city is also known as the site of the largest Romanian pilgrimage which take place each year, in October.

THE PALAS ENSEMBLE

The Palas multifunctional building complex is the largest investment in the real estate sector outside Bucharest, worth over 265 million euros, made by Iulius Group. The Uni Project, inaugurated in May 2012, introduced the concept of a “lifestyle center” on the domestic market.

Situated in the historical center of Iasi, near the Palace of Culture, the urbanistic ensemble attracts over 12 million visitors every year.



Palas includes shopping, shopping street, 5 meeting rooms, offices, a 4 * hotel, underground parking of 2,500 seats, park and green areas over 50,000 sqm.

Palas is also recognized as a business pole, thanks to its first office component, where many multinational companies operate in areas such as IT, finance, engineering engineering, consulting and insurance. The Unic Business Center features 6 Class A office buildings, distinguished by state-of-the-art technical features and modern facilities.

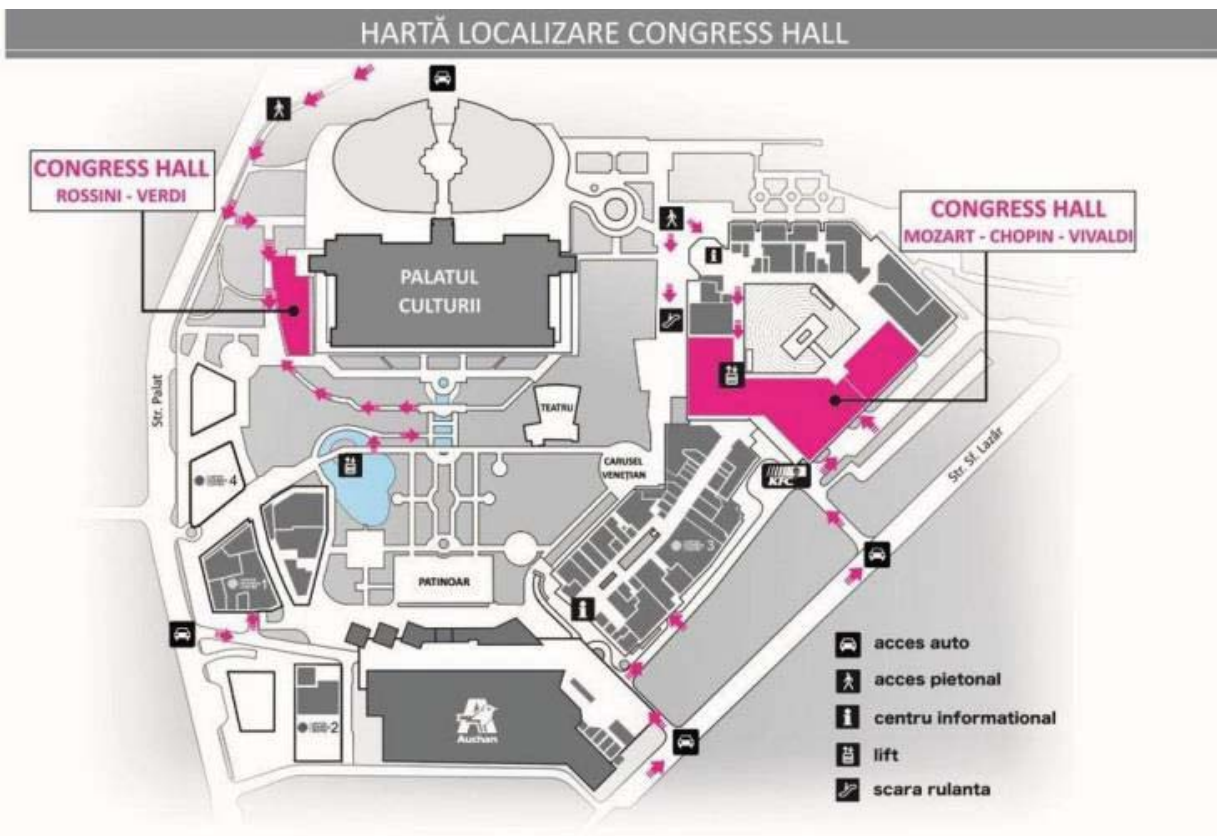

Enjoy the charm of the former capital of Moldavian region, the perfume of linden trees and the ancient stories of the mitropolit and the princes who made from this old town a point of interest in the medieval Europe. Be part of the events that occur in the city that proudly calls itself “the Capital of Culture” from Romania.



Start the visit with a walk in the Palace Square and review the main monuments in the area: Palace of Culture (the former palace of Moldavian rulers), Palas Mall Gardens, St. Nicholas Church, Dosoftei House.

Continue the visit with the monuments situated along the Stefan cel Mare Boulevard: Three Hierarchs Church, Catholic Cathedral, Metropolitan Church, City Hall Palace and the National Theater.

Travel to the Unirii Square to see the Alexandru Ioan Cuza Monument and its historical buildings, Select Hotel and Traian Hotel (built by Gustave Eiffel). Walk up the Copou Boulevard to feel the pulse of the university heart of Iasi; allow yourself a moment of relaxation and day-dreaming in the The Hall of the Lost Footsteps from “Alexandru Ioan Cuza” University, 120 meters in length, painted in fresco by Sabin Balasa.

Make a short visit in the Copou Garden, to see the 250 years old linden tree known as the place where Mihai Eminescu, the greatest poet of the Romanians, used to rest and to find sources of inspiration.

8 - NEW TECHNOLOGIES

Background: Improvements in Dental Technologies make it possible to produce ceramic restorations in single appointment. With the help of CAD/CAM systems, dentist could produce better fitting restorations in shorter time periods. **Materials and Method:** 46-year-old female patient was applied in Bezmialem Foundation University Department of Prosthodontics. During intraoral examination (#11) right central incisor with full ceramic restorations was observed fractured horizontally at apical region with metallic pivot post material. The crown was removed and it was observed that core material was also fractured at the same level. The patient accepted the treatment for a new post core and full ceramic restoration. Digital impression was made. A multilayer crown was designed and milled from zirconia (inCorisZI) as a substructure and a feldspatic ceramic (CerecBlocs, Sirona) restoration for upperstructure. The zirconia substructure was designed as an anatomical post-core. The restoration was cemented with a resin cement. **Results:** The restoration was aesthetically and functionally compatible. There was no problem in fitting on periapical images. **Conclusions:** Chairside restorations can enhance patients satisfaction and save time in crown production. CAD/CAD systems provides single visit solutions. Zirconia can provide aesthetic core for full ceramic crowns and also has sufficient strength.

9 - ORAL DIAGNOSIS – ORAL RADIOLOGY

Background: Early detection of oral cancer could improve therapeutic results and reduce morbidity and mortality. The main objective in doing this research was to access the diagnostic accuracy of conventional oral examination (COE) and light-based detection, used singly or in combination, for the early detection of potentially malignant disorder (PMD) or oral cancer development. This manuscript systematically examines the literature data associated with oral cancer screening methods and case-finding aids in this context. Are all the techniques and methods available on the market really valuable and evidence-based supported? Can they be used in everyday dentistry alone or as a supplement to the traditional intra and extraoral head and neck

exam? Research explains why oral cancer screening in the dental set up is important. We will present the variety of values of the certain diagnostic methods and their potential implication in the routine dental visits as the first line of defense with these life-threatening oral diseases.

RADIOLOGIC FINDINGS OF TWO PALATINAL TONSILLOLITH CASES

9 - ORAL DIAGNOSIS – ORAL RADIOLOGY

Background: Tonsillolith is dystrophic calcification that occurs in degenerative and dead tissues in normal individuals with serum calcium and phosphate levels. Soft tissue calcifications rarely seen in the jaw-and-palate region are usually found incidentally during routine radiographic examinations. Clinically, it appear as single or multiple, yellow or white, hard, round masses on tonsillary crypts. Small calcifications often cause no clinical signs and symptoms, whereas wider calcifications can cause symptoms such as chronic sore throat, cough, swallowing difficulty, bad breath, bad taste and foreign substance sensation. Radiographically, the panoramic radiograph is seen as a superposition of radioopacities on a single or multiple, oropharyngeal airway, mandible ramus. It can be observed bilaterally even though it is observed one-sidedly with many times. Density is more intense than bone density, and the most common appearance is multiple, small, irregularly clustered radiopacities. The differential diagnosis are osteosclerosis and enostoses, calcific granuloma, sialolith, malignancy, phlebolith, syphilis. Numerous and difficult to reach tonsillitis are followed, but they may need to be removed if they reach very large sizes and become symptomatic. In this case report, panoramic and cone-beam computed tomography datas of bilateral and diffuse tonsillolith which is incidentally detected in the oropharyngeal region of two male patients with 47 and 58-year-old are presented.

Background: Osteosarcoma is a primary malignant bone tumor resulting into osteoid or bone and accounts for 23% of craniofacial malignancies. Osteosarcomas of the jaws account for 2-10% of all sarcomas. It has been observed that osteosarcomas affect more commonly in mandible than in maxilla. However, there is no difference according to sex, but some authors consider that it
