By plane:

BOLOGNA AIRPORT

Bologna airport named “Guglielmo Maroni” is 35km far from Ferrara (about 30 minutes by car).

The region set a new flybus service between Bologna airport and Ferrara called “bus&fly”.

Ferrara/ Bologna rail line is direct (www.trenitalia.it), the airport is connected to the trainstation by means of a direct bus system named “aerobus” and provides direct flights to the most important Italian and European cities all year.

Free entrance: Palazzo Schifanoia




