M.I.N.E. PROJECT

GOALS

1. to increase the knowledge and the direct participation of young people, politicians and experts in the VI Cycle of the Structured Dialogue;

2. to draw up a document with proposals and operative suggestions in order to enrich the subsequent program regarding Youth: R.E.S.T.A document. This document contains the key concepts emerged from the common reflection (Reflect), the innovative contents discussed (Talk), the operative proposals and the programmatic points to be submitted to politicians (local level, European national level) and to the territorial stakeholders (Suggest), the resources and personal possibilities for the concrete realization of the proposals presented (Engage), the list of activities to be put into practice to facilitate the transmission of the document and its best diffusion (Achieve);

3. to increase European awareness and the active involvement of participants in designing and implementing processes and paths aimed at achieving the objectives of the EU;

4. to stimulate the participation of young people at risk of social exclusion in local decision-making processes to increase their active and conscious citizenship;

5. to increase and stimulate the political participation of young people: on a local level, through greater knowledge of political representations; on a European level, learning to confront politicians from different contexts and identifying together common strategies and solutions.

PARTNER - MACEDONIA

• at theCool Youth-Association for Cultural and Educational Development and Goce Delcev University in Shtip (Macedonia), the topic of self-entrepreneurship will be discussed

• PARTNER - SLOVENIA

• at the Municipality of Novo Mesto and the Association for the development of volunteerism Novo Mesto (Slovenia) the topic of Social inclusion in the digital world will be discussed

• PARTNER - SPAGNA

• the municipality of La Palma del Condado and the federation Red Juvenil Conect (Spain) will reflect on the theme 'School' of Racism. Migrants and Migrants Urban Integration and urban integration.

• PARTNER - ITALIA

• at the Municipality of Taviano and the Accademia Nuovi Studi Internazionali (ANSI) (Italy) the participants will deal with the theme Creativity-Culture-Territory Promotion.

M.I.N.E. PROJECT - ACTIVITIES AND REALIZATION TIME

PHASE 1 - PREPARATION: JANUARY - MARCH 2018

In this phase the following activities are carried out:

meetings between the working group according to the methods indicated above;

preparation of seminars;

creation of the project's logo and informative material;

FB page creation for foreign communications;

opening of the means of contact between the participants and for the staff, as previously defined;

participation in the consultation questionnaire of young Europeans for the preparation of the new European Council resolution about Youth (6th Cycle of the Structured Dialogue).

M.I.N.E. PROJECT - ACTIVITIES AND REALIZATION TIME

PHASE 2 - IMPLEMENTATION: APRIL - JULY 2018

4 Meetings - one in each partner country – **three-day long** (trips excluded) to which will take part: 4 young people, 1 politician for each sending country, 1 expert on the topic dealt with, 1 facilitator (identified by the hosting organization), the 16 young people identified (12 direct participants and 4 with fewer opportunities) and the 3 politicians of the host country.

At the end of each meeting a chapter of the R.E.ST.A Document is written.

M.I.N.E. PROJECT - ACTIVITIES AND REALIZATION TIME

PHASE 3 - DISSEMINATION: AUGUST - DECEMBER 2018

In this phase the following activities are carried out:

preparation of a final press release of the project (in English and in each of the project languages) to be sent to both printed and online newspapers;

dissemination at European, local and national level of the R.E.S.T.A. Document, of the educational process implemented, of the results achieved and of the working methods used.

The official language of the project and activities is English, but the use of the mother tongue for advertising and communication of project contents in different local contexts is expected.

M.I.N.E - PREPARATION OF EACH MEETING

The meetings foreseen by the project are 4 and for each of them the same preparation method has been prepared. Each territorial partner (association + municipality) will be responsible for organizing the local meeting, in coordination with the other partners.

In particular, the partners will be involved in:

- preparation of internal and external spaces for the realization of the activities;
- organization of the materials necessary for the meeting;

- management of contact with the participants before the seminar and at the end of it, for the collection of feedbacks;
- identification of at least 1 facilitator who supports the group during the activities of the meeting;
- communication and dissemination of the meeting on a local / national level via press releases, production of posters with the project logo and local partners', the use of FB pages and websites managed by local partners;
- contact with other subjects interested in subject matter: students from local schools, university students, local youths, politicians from municipalities and surrounding areas, representatives of associations and private bodies. During each meeting, citizens will be invited to take part in the event planned outside the territory

This is a particularly important moment both for the involvement of the local community on the issues of the active and direct participation on a European level, and in view of a possible widening of contributions to reflection that may arise from the meeting with the citizens. The realization mode of the final event is the speakers' corner, that is a meeting with local young people and adults in which the participants talk about the contents that emerged during the meeting.

M.I.N.E. PROJECT - PARTICIPANTS

12 young people in each country are expected to participate, invested with multiple tasks such as organizing a local meeting with political decision-makers and experts; the involvement of other young people and adults during the entire duration of the project and in the opening and comparison with the territory in each meeting; the participation (4 for each country) to the different project meetings, contributing their contribution and point of view and bringing the contents and decisions taken at local level.

The **politicians directly involved** in the project belong to the Municipalities of: Taviano (I), Mestna obcina Novo mesto (SLO), Stip (MK), La Palma del Condado (E). In close collaboration with the local young people, they will have the task of preparing, organizing and participating in local meetings; to be present (1 for each country) to the different project meetings, making their contribution in terms of experience and knowledge; to report the contents of the meetings and decisions taken within the institution they belong to; to give maximum spread to the project in all its phases at local, regional and national level and, where possible, to involve other territories and realities both public and private.

M.I.N.E. PROJECT - INVOLVEMENT OF YOUNG PARTICIPANTS

During the preparation phase of each meeting, a closed group on FB will be created, to which the selected participants and experts will be added to facilitate the knowledge and interaction between everyone and to get to the heart of the project contents.

The online activities that precede each meeting are:

- games that allow the participants to interact an get to know each other: the participants will be asked to post a photo, a drawing, an image of a star and to indicate over each tip of its, five simple information: "a word that defines me", "a my interest "," I take care of "," my favorite reading "," participation in the project in one word ";
- such ideas will be prepared by each expert; the expert will have the task of associating the participants with the topic at least 1 month before the seminar through: video-stimuli, sending articles / laws / texts, questions for reflection, etc.

- a questionnaire to evaluate the incoming skills. In case of need / difficulty in filling it in, the participants will be able to count on the support of the operators / officials of the partner organizations. Moreover, starting from the preparation phase, the participants will be invited to follow the work related to the 6th Cycle of the Structured Dialogue, expressing their opinion and participating in online questionnaires and consultations.

The online activities carried out at the end of each meeting are:

- a final questionnaire to evaluate the output skills developed / enhanced;
- additional contributions to the preparation of the R.E.S.T.A.

Each organization will offer its support to its participants by providing them with operators / officials who can be contacted in case of need / difficulty in completing the final questionnaire.

M.I.N.E. PROJECT - DISSEMINATION -

On a local level the aim of the activities is to make the process and working methods linked to the structured dialogue known, to present the final work with all its contributions (**R.E.S.T.A. docu-ment**), to invite other young people and political decision-makers to take part in the collective life starting from a local level to then reach a European one, to increase the knowledge of the Erasmus+ program and the Structured Dialogue specifically. Each local partner (association + municipality), in the month of November 2018, will organize a meeting **open to the territory** (Open Space).

The meeting's features will be:

- the creation of 4 positions related to the 4 thematic areas of the Document (Social inclusion in the digital world, migrants and urban integration, self-entrepreneurship, creativity-culture and territory promotion);
- the initial presentation of the different spaces in which the participants in the project are split;
- the explanation of the meeting modalities (the Open Space principles) and timing;
- a brief summary of the debate on each topic and the collection of questions / suggestions / requests.

Participation will be open and free for local young people and adults, local politicians of neighbouring municipalities and stakeholders (young entrepreneurs, association managers, Municipality managers and technicians, SPRAR referents, architects, etc.). The minimum number of attendance is 40 people per country.
