families with favorable socio-economic status. The oral hygiene status was estimated using the OHI-S index. The particularitis of oral hygiene care in children were studied by the questionnaire method. The study was conducted in accordance with ethical requirements, with the written consent of the parents of children or the legal representatives. Results: in children in group L1 the average value of the index OHI-S=2,62±0,12, in opposed to 1,12±0,18 in L0. Just 14,13±2,07% children of L1 had good oral hygiene, 27,92±2,67% children - fair oral hygiene, 57.95±2,93% - poor oral hygiene. 68.20±2,77% of the children in L1 were practiced a single toothbrush in the day, mostly in the morning until breakfast, applying an incorrect technique. The majority of children in L1 considerably exceed the terms of use of oral hygiene items and parents do not create the sanogenic environment required in the family environment. Conclusions: This study established the poor state of oral hygiene in socially disadvantaged children, lower levels of hygienic culture and lack of sanogenic behavior in the familiar environment, which must be taken into account when planning preventive measures in oral health programs.

PP 122 SALIVA ANTIOXIDANT CAPACITY AND DENTAL CARIES IN CHILDREN BETWEEN THE AGE 4 TO 6

Background: The saliva has various defence mechanisms such as the immune and enzyme systems, defence against bacteria, viruses, fungi and protection of the oral mucosa as it promotes its curative features. Our research is focused on the correlation of the DMF index and the antioxidant capacity of saliva. Aim: 100 children from both genders, aged between 4 and 6 from the local nurseries from the town Shtip were the examinees. The first group of 30 were children with DMF =0 divided in a control group and 70 children with DMF - experimental group. For the detection of the DMF we used the Klein - Palmer index, DMFT. Materials and Methods: We used prepared sets Total Antioxidant Capacity(PAO) Assay, Biomedica Company, USA and the method is due to the substance 2,2'-azino-bis (3-ethylbenzothiazoline-6-sulphonic acid) or ABTS which we incubated with peroxidase and hydrogen peroxide whereupon radical cation, ABTS+ were formed with relatively stable blue-green colour and a measured intensity of 600 nm. Results: The tested ration between the total antioxidants in the saliva of children with first dentition and the presence of dental caries is R= -0,44(p<0,05), whereupon a medium strong negative relevant correlation was determined in both tested groups. The increase of the total presence of antioxidants in the saliva of children is followed with a decreased presence of dental caries of children. Conclusion: The antioxidant activity of the saliva is related to the increase of the suspension of proteins and

cariogenic activity, the total antioxidant capacity is increased in children with caries compared to the caries-free children it showed no statistical importance.

Background: The intake of nutrients influences the growth and development of oro-facial structures, oral mucosa and can be a major factor in the occurrence of dental diseases such as caries, enamel defects, erosions and periodontal diseases. The aim of this study is to investigate the changes in dietary intake of children with disorders in oral structures and after prosthetic treatment. Material and Methods: 58 subjects aged 3 to 18 are included in the study. They are divided into two groups - first is from children with oral disorders and the second is with children after prosthetic treatments. After examination of the 24-hour diet, the amount and quality of the ingested micronutrients is established and compared with normal intake rates for the respective age. Results: There is statistically significant correlation (P = 0.024) between the disorders of the oral structures and increased fat intake. Children in this group prefer low-molecular carbohydrate foods, poor in minerals and vitamins, easy for chewing. In the group with prosthetic treatments, lower fat intake is found compared to the first group (38.9% of total daily energy), but the values are also above the age limit (from 25% to 35%). Reduced fiber intake is found for both groups (respectively 11.8 and 13.3 g / per day). Conclusion: To assess the the nutrition and its impact on oral health, it is necessary to develop and implement a screening system which evaluate the possibility of balanced nutrition in dental clinical practice.
