Zlatka Miteva, one of the most interesting flutists of the younger generation from Macedonia, wa in 1980. She graduated from the National Music Academy Pancho Vladigerov in Sofia, Bulg the class of Professor Lydia Oshavkova. Having completed her master studies at the same Music emy, Ms Miteva was awarded the title of concert soloist. Zlatka Miteva pursued professional advan at courses held by eminent flautists and professors Andras Adorian, Patrick Gallois, Lydia Osha Marina Novak, Claudio Ferrarini and Mario Caroli. As a recepient of scholarship of the Accadem iana Del Flauto, Ms Miteva attended a specialist course on Flautissimo 2013 in Rome, Italy. Her include the State Scholarship in Bulgaria and three grands from Open Society Institute. Zlatka Mite the winner of numerous national and international awards, such as the Special award in the chamber category at the International festival Music and Earth in Sofia, Bulgaria; first prize in the solo flui gory at the National Music Competition in Macedonia; second and third prize at the National Comp on Chamber Music; and finalist at the International Competition Petar Konjovich in Belgrade, Serbi soloist, Ms. Miteva has had performances with the Macedonian Symphony Orchestra, Academic phony Orchestra, Vraca Symphony Orchestra. Zlatka Miteva took part in reputed music festivals in tia (Dubrovnik Music Festivals, InterFox Festival in Osijek), in Slovenia (First European Picollo vals), in Bulgaria (Appolonia Music Festivals, European Music Festival in Varna, International F March Music Days in Ruse), in Macedonia (Inter Fest, Skopje Summer Fest, Stip Summer Fest, Summer Fest) and other European countries. She also performed in recital concerts in Italy, Greece garia, Croatia, Slovenia, Hungary, Germany, and USA. In 2010, Zlatka Miteva created TRIO DEMICO (flute, clarinet and piano). Performing they've had very successfully concert tours in cities across Macedonia, Bulgaria, Serbia, Hungary and Croatia. As a classical flutist, Ms. Mite performed contemporary works, with interest in the newest trends and research in contemporary She is also a member of the Ensemble of Contemporary Music ConTempora. As of 2009, Zlatka M Flute Professor at the Music Academy in Stip, Macedonia.

Natasha Trbojevikj was born on 23rd May 1965 in Shtip. She completed her Primery and Seconda sic education in Primary and Secondary Music School in Shtip in the piano class of the Professor Bikova... She continued her education at the Faculty of Music, St. Cyril and Methodius Unive Skopje in the piano class of the Professor Lepsha Piperkovska, got the MA degree in the piano of the Proffesor Evuska Trpkova Elezovic. During her studies, she performed a number of solo conc ganized by the Music youth of Macedonia and Young music artists as well as competitions organ the Faculty of Music. She also took part in the piano trio in the class of Professor M. Kufojanakis fessor of Chamber music. Natasha has attended piano seminars such as Timakin, A. Valdma, B. Ro Jokut Mihajloviki, D. Trbojeviki piano Congress in Novi Sad (1991). Since 1988 she started worki piano teacher in the Secondary Music School in Shtip. She worked simultaneously in the Music Sc Vranje and Bujanovac in Serbia from 1988-1992. She belongs to the first generation of graduate pi Shtip and a founder of the piano class in the Music School in Shtip. She was a jury member of pia chamber music state competitions in Skopje and Bitola from 2003 to 2009. Not only does she wo music pedagogue, she is also an accompanist. She has participated in many state and international titions and won numerous prizes in Skopje, Bitola, Belgrade, Ljubljana, Herceg Novi etc. Since 20 tasha has worked as an accompanist at the Music Academy at UGD in Shtip, together with the cla clarinet, trumpet and solo singing. She took part in all concerts organized by Music Academy ininternational and state competitions. Since 2016 she became an University Former Assistant Profe Musik Academy in University Goce Delcev in Stip. Since 2007 – 2016 she performed in 3 solo c (in Stip, Veles and Skopje) and almost 40 concerts, with many music soloists: Boris Trajanov (b Blagica Pop Tomova (sopran), Dimitar Kozuharov (bas baritone), Natasa Pandazieva (mezzo so Zlatka Miteva (flute), Branko Pavlovski (Clarinet), with the piano duo Trbojevikj - Nastovski,10 c with Trio Academico together with Zlatka Miteva and Branko Pavlovski in R. Macedonia, Serbia, and Hungary.
