

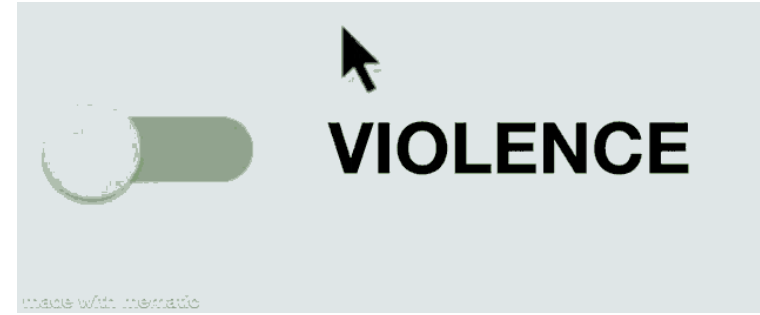

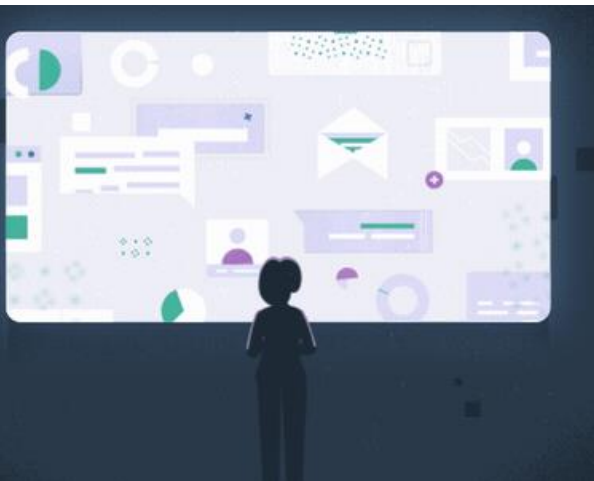
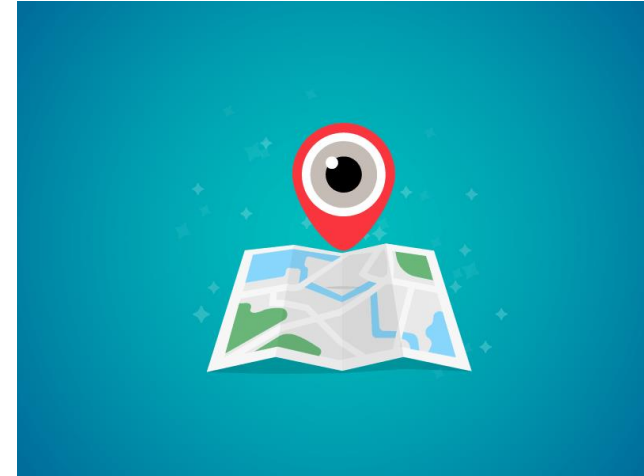
- Online vulnerability of migrants:

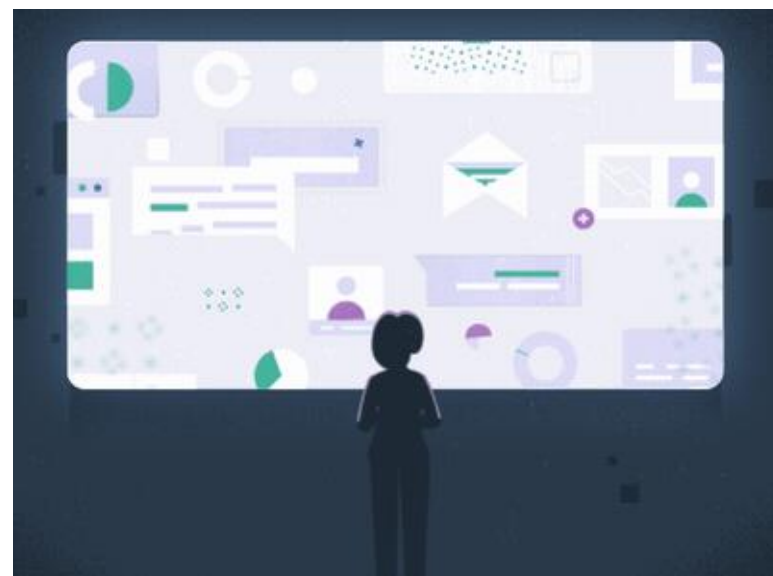
