The second edition of the TCP Forum, took place in the beautiful city of **Lecce**, Italy in 2016. The third chapter followed in **Liverpool**, United Kingdom, at the beginning of 2018, the fourth edition was held in **Budapest**, Hungary at the end of 2018, the fifth edition was held in **San Lorenzo de El Escorial**, Madrid in October 2019, the sixth **Cyprus** edition took place **digitally** in spring of 2020, due to covid-19 restrictions. Unfortunately the 2021 edition which was about to take place in Malta was cancelled due to the covid-19 pandemic. Use social enterprise, social and digital innovation and non-formal learning as a way to encourage and enable young people to **sustain** their **entrepreneurial life skills**.

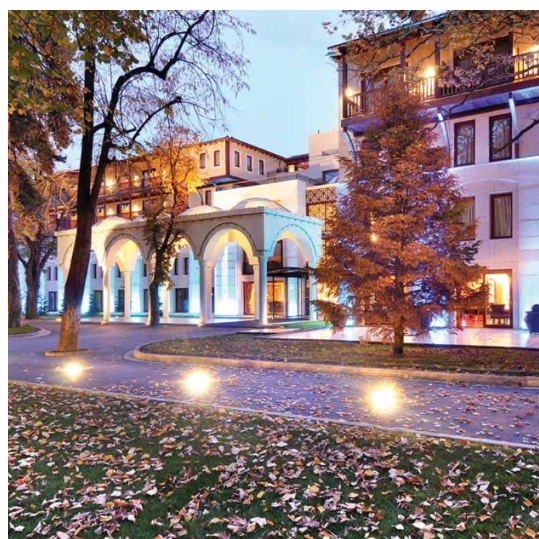
**Encourage** creativity, innovation, participation, solidarity, diversity and social inclusion of young people.

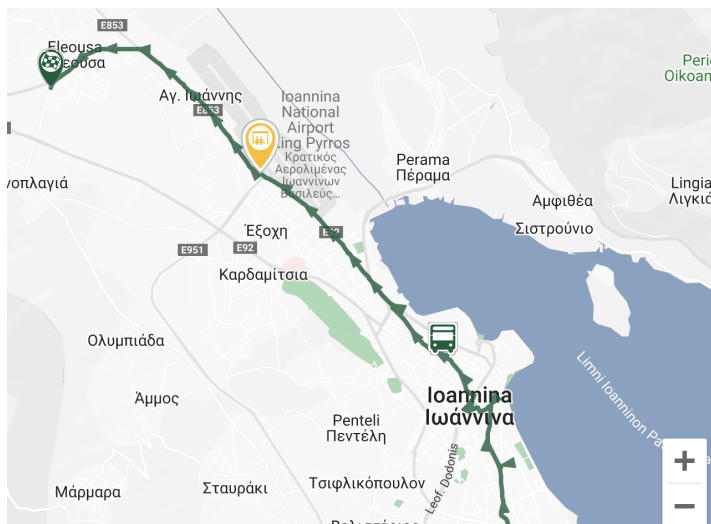
## HOW TO GET TO THE AIRPORT FROM THE AIRPORT?

Grand Serai Congress & Spa is located at the very entrance of the city of Ioannina and the heart of the town and nearby attractions are just a few minutes away.

You can reach the hotel in the following 2 ways:

### BUS:

#### > Bus Route 02



Step outside the airport and find the bus station. You will hop in the bus No.02 (There is a bus every 20 minutes).

This bus is heading towards the centre, you will stop in the bus station "Tzami".

From there the hotel is just 5 mins walk.

**Note:** Please have in mind that Google Maps don't show any public transportation routes or bus stations in Ioannina, this doesn't mean that they don't exist. Feel free to ask around in case you are in doubt!

### TAXI:

Hop on a taxi once you exit the airport. Prices might vary so please ask the driver beforehand.

**Note:** Please note that you are responsible for covering the costs for your transportation from the airport to the Hotel and vice versa.

### Weather:

Ioannina generally enjoys hot, dry, and clear summers but long, cold and very rainy winters so please be prepared and check out the forecast closer to the date of your departure.
