EXPERIENCES AND LESSONS FROM ONLINE TEACHING OF GROUP OF MUSIC SUBJECTS DURING THE PANDEMIC COVID 19 AT THE FACULTY OF PEDAGOGY – SKOPJE

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- The Government of the Republic of North Macedonia made a decision to transfer the entire education system to online teaching.
- A national platform for primary and secondary schools (www.eduino.gov.mk) has been promoted, prepared by the Ministry of Education, and BDE with the support of UNICEF.
- The universities autonomously decided the platform for online teaching (Microsoft Teams, Zoom, Google Classroom)
- At the Faculty of Pedagogy UKIM, there was an opportunity to combine the various platforms for online teaching

ONLINE EDUCATION 2020-2022

- Macedonia does not have a developed information infrastructure, especially in rural areas
- The educational system faced challenges and uncertainties in organizing and implementing online teaching
- This research was initiated to detect the problems and improve online teaching at the Faculty of Pedagogy "St. Kliment Ohridski" UKIM in Skopje.

A GROUP OF MUSIC SUBJECTS AT THE FACULTY OF PEDAGOGY

- The fundamentals of music education with music instruments,
- Music education with didactics,
- Creative music workshop
- The general goal is to acquire musical literacy: reading, writing, reproducing, intoning musical text, playing musical instruments - keyboard, recorder and Orff's instruments
- This implies theoretical and practical mastery of the content because future teachers are expected to implement this knowledge creatively in teaching children.
- The online teaching was realized through the Zoom platform
- Additionaly, recorded video materials of the lecturer were used

THE PURPOSE OF THE STUDY

- Detect the problems and improve online teaching of the subject of music education at the Faculty of Pedagogy, UKIM Skopje to the group of students in the Turkish teaching language
- To investigate the attitudes of students on the effects of Covid-19 on the educational process in order to determine the advantages and disadvantages
- In this way, we get an insight into the experiences that would improve online teaching for some future needs.



- METHODS OF QUALITATIVE RESEARCH
- A QUESTIONNAIRE WAS DISTRIBUTED DURING THE WINTER SEMESTER OF 2022
- THE SAMPLE INCLUDED 14 STUDENTS FROM THE 3RD AND 4TH YEARS OF THE TURKISH TEACHING LANGUAGE GROUP WHO HAD COMPLETED THE ONLINE TEACHING IN THE PREVIOUS TWO YEARS.



 THE QUESTIONNAIRE INCLUDED 21 OPEN-ENDED QUESTIONS THAT RELATED TO:

A) THE TECHNOLOGICAL TOOLS AND SPATIAL CONDITIONS
B) THE EFFECTS OF COVID-19 ON THE EDUCATIONAL PROCESS
C) THE EFFECTS OF COVID-19 ON THE MUSIC EDUCATION PROCESS
D) STUDENTS' ATTITUDES TOWARDS ONLINE LEARNING.

Conclusions:

Advantages of online teaching:

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Cost reduction for transport and living expenses;

Ability to re-watch recorded lectures, presentations and video materials;

Disadvantages of online teaching:

- Insufficient socialization, interaction and communication identical to traditional classes

- The difficulties regarding the practical part of learning (playing instruments, singing, counting complex rhythm patterns);

- Inability to do internship in school.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Teachers and students should undergo training on innovative technology for developed music softwares and special programs for virtual internship in school classes
- Research results can facilitate educational institutions and policy makers to bring online teaching to a higher level as e-learning is increasingly growing in the world as a modern way to improve the education process and improve learning performance.
