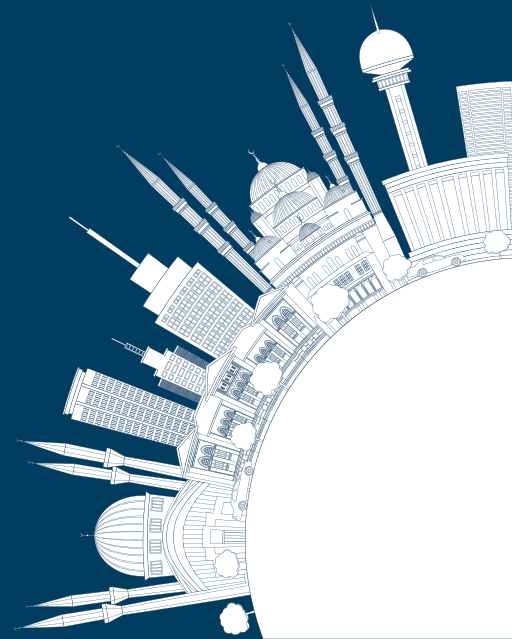

## Abstract

The integration of Artificial Intelligence (AI) into English teaching is transforming conventional pedagogies, providing customized, effective, and scalable learning. This paper discusses the applications of AI-based tools like intelligent tutoring systems, chatbots, automated feedback in writing, and adaptive language learning platforms. These technologies improve learner engagement, offer immediate feedback, and facilitate differentiated instruction according to unique learning needs.
