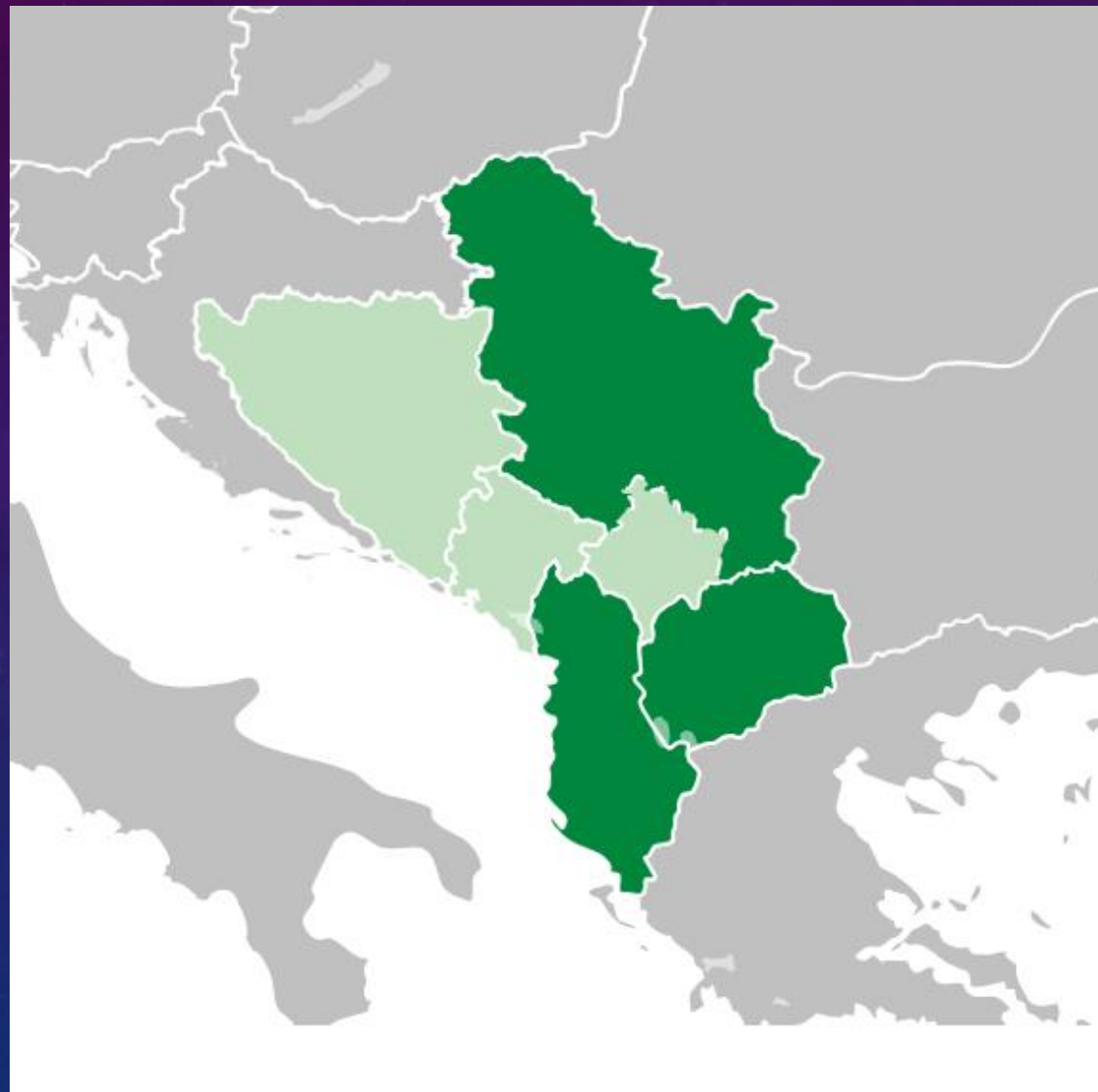
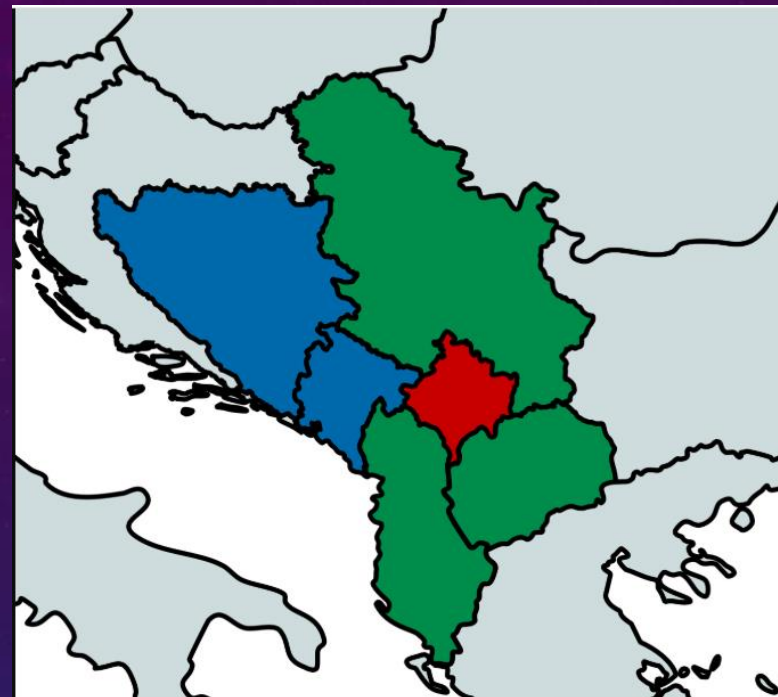

GEOGRAPHICAL MAP OF "OPEN BALKAN" INITIATIVE

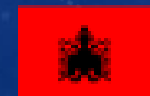
