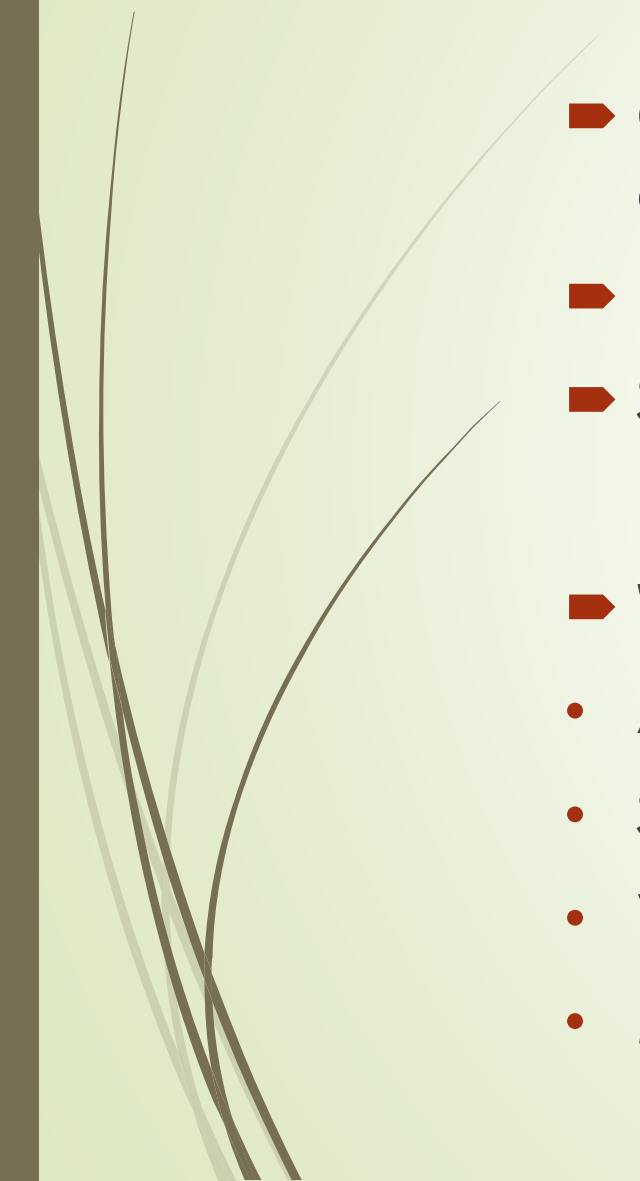

- Connect with native speakers or international learners

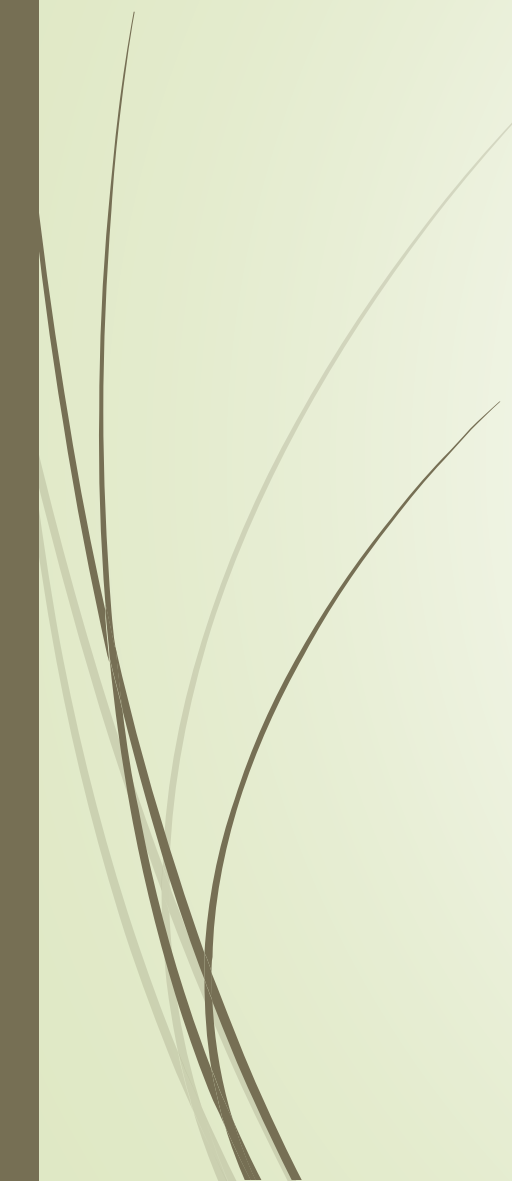


# Advantages of Computer-Based Learning
