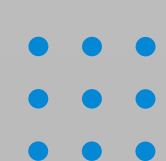

About Vienna

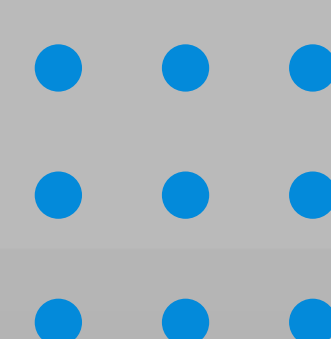


This year's conference will be held in the historic city of Vienna. A dream destination for many travelers, Vienna is the social and cultural capital of Central Europe and should not be missed!
